Vision 2020

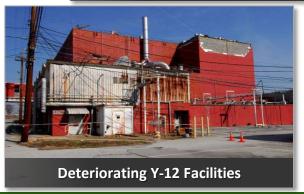
Remaining portion of ETTP cleaned up and reindustrialized

- Complete K-27 Demolition

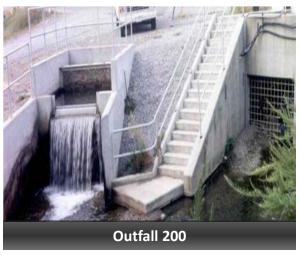




Budget development is mindful of outyear priorities (FY19-FY22)

- Design Sludge Processing Facility

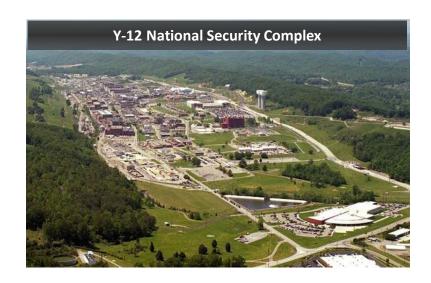




There is still much work to do
