Dickson	Montgomery Bell State Park	\$200,000.00	To construct an ADA accessible paved trail around ball field, into the campground and through the woods towards the visitor center, outdoor fitness equipment, ADA accessible picnic tables and signage and interpretation signage following themes of nature, history and conservation.
Haywood	City of Brownsville	\$200,000.00	To acquire land to develop a walking trail, construct a trail head pavilion, a fitness equipment area, a parking lot, site amenities and ADA accessible walkways and surfaces.

Sevier	City of Sevierville	\$200,000.00	To extend the existing greenway from West Prong of the Little Pigeon River to Gatlinburg Hwy Bridge. Paved trail and upgrades to existing lighting with LED technology on original greenway, installation of a new Emergency Way Finding System designed for both pedestrian recognition and for/to connection to the local 911 system via the GPS technology.
Union	Rocky Fork State Park	\$167,000.00	To purchase of prefabricated powder-coated aluminum bridge and necessary hardware, concrete bridge abutments. Rental of boom forklift and skid steer to transport materials to site and assist with assembly. Purchase of trail construction and maintenance to be used only for trail maintenance at the ingress and egress of proposed bridge and for search and rescue/emergency medical response for visitors on the trail.
Wilson	Cedars of Lebanon State Park	\$175,000.00	To renovate the trail system at Cedars of Lebanon State Park. All of the trails within the parks trail system will see renovations including the addition of trail head kiosks and improved signs.

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
